Hotel Sanders

The Hotel Sanders is one of the best places in Copenhagen to lay down your hat, bringing together the best of modern design in one place. Located behind Copenhagen's Royal Theatre, it opened its doors on 1 November 2017 under the leadership of star dancer Alexander Kølpin. Imparting his theatricality and keen sense of detail, the Danish designer explores the influences between colonial spirit, British plays and Parisian sets, with the help of the Lind + Almond studio. The result is 54 cozy rooms, lounges featuring works of art from the Dais Contemporary collections, a lush winter garden and a charming restaurant with seasonal cuisine.
